- ▶ A 100% subsidiary of Caisse des dépôts
 - French public financial institution
 - Working closely with french local authorities for more that 40 years
 - Who help financing public initiatives, especialy in territorial development

- ▶ Our expertise is in three areas
 - Investment in Carbon Assets : provide a new ressource to low carbon projects
 - Climate Market Services : tools to implement climat policies
 - Public research in the economics of Climate Change

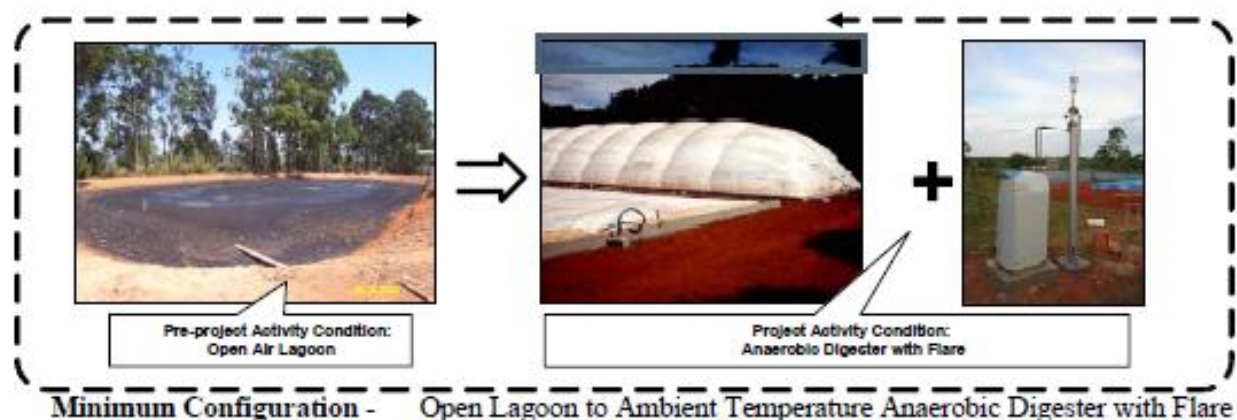
- ▶ Our experience
 - Provider of Carbon registry services in more than 10 countries
 - Invested in 4 Carbon funds, from 2005 on. (ECF, Post2012, FCCM, FCPF)
 - Invested directly in JI projects in France

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- ▶ Capture and **combustion of methane from swine manure. Innovative PoA on a large scale.**
- ▶ Implementation of the technology on **800 farms** of various sizes resulted in **290 000tCO₂eq emission reductions in 2007.**
- ▶ CDC Climat **brought in private investors** through the creation of a fund, and a **management capacity.**



- ▶ Two folds JI bundle of projects :
 - **Fuel Switch : Coal to biomass**
 - **Behaviour evolution : dry flat instead of in swathes**
- ▶ Implementation of the technology on 16 projects, most of them in the Champagne-Ardennes region, resulted in **700 ktCO₂eq** emission reductions.
- ▶ CDC Climat helped the french government to launch a call for projects, helped project developers :
 - to **organised around a program coordinator** to bundle the 16 projects
 - to get a **methodology and PDD validated**,
 - to **find an auditor**,
 - And **invested in the program**, buying the ERU.

- ▶ Currently developing partnerships with french regions
- ▶ Would like to trigger **regional Carbon funds** :
 - With one or more regions
 - For local projects or for international cooperation projects
 - Based on the strenghs of the regions (territories and players knowledge)
 - And of the strengh of a fund (bring together more investors)
- ▶ Work closely to **promote the importance of projects based mechanisms** (CDM and JI or equivalent) in the Post 2012 context :
 - At the international level (COP, future of CDM/JI)
 - At the European level (art 24a, credits acceptance in the EU-ETS)
 - In other emerging Carbon cap and trades
